

<u>History</u>

At the beginning of the 17th century, the London Companies developed the city and created the particular layout of the streets of the city center.

During the war in 1689-1691

Coleraine was a resistance centre to the rule of James.II. Richard Hamilton's Irish army failed to capture the city.

The city has developed after the second world war with the expansion of the river port, and the development of the railway.

The University of Ulster has 5,000 students. All these young people make the city attractive and multi-cultural.

The city is twinned with La Roche-sur-Yon in France since 1980.

The **Coleraine Town Hall** is the city hall and is located right in the middle of the city center square.


The building is rather imposing and is very long and in a very strong Georgian style.
