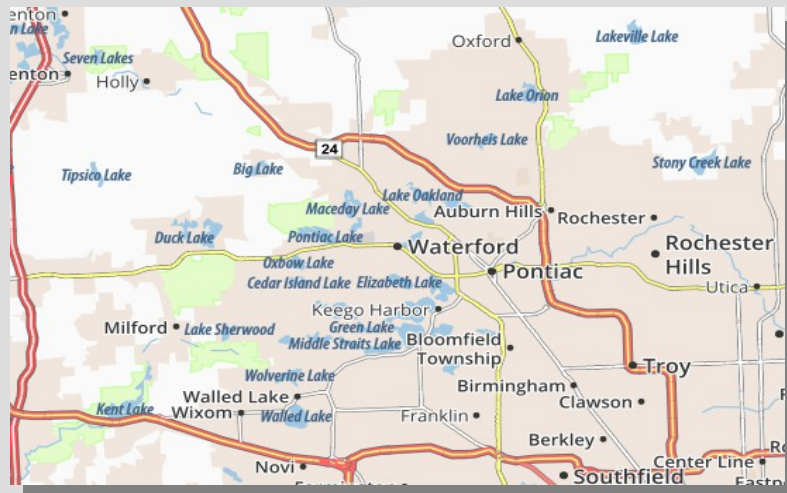

History of the city

Waterford is created in 914 after the invasion of the Vikings. It is the oldest city of Ireland.

In the middle Ages, Waterford was the second most important city after Dublin.

The city is built on the south bank of the river Suir. It allowed the development of its maritime activity. The port of Waterford has been one of the most important for a thousand years.

Visit the House of Waterford Crystal to discover the secrets of crystal making.

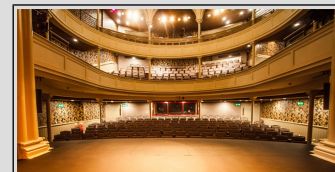
A local guide will be happy to explain how the house works.
